

# Woodbury PPA Meeting

## Minutes for August 26, 2009

**Minutes approved from the May meeting with minor changes.**

### **Old Business:**

- Laptop upgrades were paid for by the PPA and completed over the summer.
- St. Jude's rebate for playground. Scherer has not heard from them will continue to pursue.
- Box Top baggies – PPA members indicated that was a very popular idea with families. Scherer to develop a new batch of baggies to be given out at Open House (at PPA booth).

### **New Business:**

- *Learning Center Rug* – former rug was tossed due to flammability. PPA voted to purchase a new rug immediately. Cost if \$400 - \$500. Additional rugs are needed for Mathis' and Pescitellis' rooms. DeCorte to go through central office.
- *Reading Counts on the Web* – district purchased this program for Learning Center. In addition, they purchased Lexia (10 licenses) for Woodbury.
- *Edline* – will be available in October for Woodbury.
- *Lexile Numbers* – would like parents to volunteer to record Lexile book numbers by teacher room. Scherer and Knepper volunteered. Will have sheet for parents to sign at open house.
- *Christmas Play* – will be Christmas at the O.K. Corral. Practices will be Thursdays after school, and starts the last Thursday in September. Play will be December 11.
- *Additional information* – Dr. DeCorte passed around some items for the board to think about, possibly Labyrinth, and exercise stations.
