

Woodbury PPA Meeting Minutes for November 10, 2009

Minutes approved from the October 13 meeting.

Old Business:

- Bread making – Braddish to contact volunteers for baking and help with children. Baking time will be between 12:30 and 2:50. Equipment boxes are in PPA closet. Knepper to get oil, flour and spray oil.
- Replacement slide – PPA chose arch climber, 45 days until receipt. Estimated costs for installing slide are: \$54 for auger rental (\$54-3hours or \$96 for the day), 6 bags of cement (\$40). Slide itself will cost \$1,018.32. Scherer will contact supervisor to see if they'll do at no cost.
