Sandwich Community Unit School District 430 covers approximately 52 square miles and is located in northern Illinois about 30 miles southeast of DeKalb (NIU) and about 60 miles west of Chicago.

Local and comprehensive shopping centers are located within a 30-mile radius along with numerous banking options. The citizens and area doctors have established a state of the art community hospital. The district includes an agricultural base with some of the best farmland in the state.

Indian Valley Vocational Center & CTE

Indian Valley Vocational Center offers students from ten area schools the opportunity to learn realistic work skills and ethics in a work-like setting to better determine future goals and career decisions. The program offerings include automotive technology, auto body repair, aviation mechanics, certified nursing assistant, computer programming & gaming technologies, computer technology, cosmetology, construction trades, teaching methods, fire science, emergency medical services, culinary arts, graphic design, health occupations, law enforcement, sports medicine, and welding & fabrication.

Sandwich Park District

The Sandwich Park District includes sports programs, a splash park, a skate park, a conservation area and arts and crafts activities. Also, the park district hosts numerous trips to ballparks, shows, and other recreational sites.

Foundation for Educational Excellence

The Sandwich Education Foundation believes in educational enrichment through community support. The Foundation supports, promotes, supplements, and enriches the educational programs and activities of students and develops links with businesses, civic organizations, and government.

Fox Valley Older Adult Services

Fox Valley Older Adult Services provides for older adults in the counties of DeKalb, LaSalle, and Kendall. Their purpose is to encourage and enable older adults to remain in their homes and communities in their later years.

Sandwich Fairgrounds

The Sandwich Fair has been in operation since 1888 and is the final northern Illinois county fair of the season. Each year it begins its five-day run on the Wednesday following Labor Day. It's an agricultural and family fair with more exhibits than any other Illinois county fair.

Opera House

School Report Card – 2019

Sandwich CUSD 430 enrollment in 2018-2019 was 2,019 students, including 78.4% White, 0.4% Black, 17.6% Hispanic, 0.7% Asian, 0.2% American Indian, and 2.7% Two or More Races. Children with Disabilities is 17%, English Learners is 4.1%, Low Income is 37.7% and Student Mobility is 4.5%. The 2017-18 operational spending per pupil was \$11,892 compared to the states \$13,764. 63.8% of revenue funding is local; 30.0% of revenue funding is Federal.

73.8% of teacher's hold a master's degree or above compared to the state's 60.6%. Teacher retention rate is 93.0% compared to the state's 85.7%.

Average teacher salary is \$64,451 compared to the state's \$67,049; and average administrator salary is \$111,820 compared to the state's \$109,592.
